



Connect Your Phone's Wifi Hotspot

On a Google / Android Phone:

Step 1: Turn on your phone's Wi-Fi hotspot

1. Open your device's Settings app .
2. Tap **Network & Internet** > **Hotspot & tethering**.
3. Turn on **Portable Wi-Fi hotspot**.

Step 2: Customize your phone's Wi-Fi hotspot settings


1. Open your device's Settings app .
2. Tap **Network & Internet** > **Hotspot & tethering**.
3. Tap **Set up Wi-Fi hotspot**.
4. Tap the option that you want to change. Follow the on-screen steps.
5. Tap **Save**.

Tip: If you don't want your hotspot to require a password, pick **None** under "Security."

Step 3: Connect devices to your phone's Wi-Fi hotspot

You can share your phone's mobile data with up to 10 other devices via a Wi-Fi hotspot.

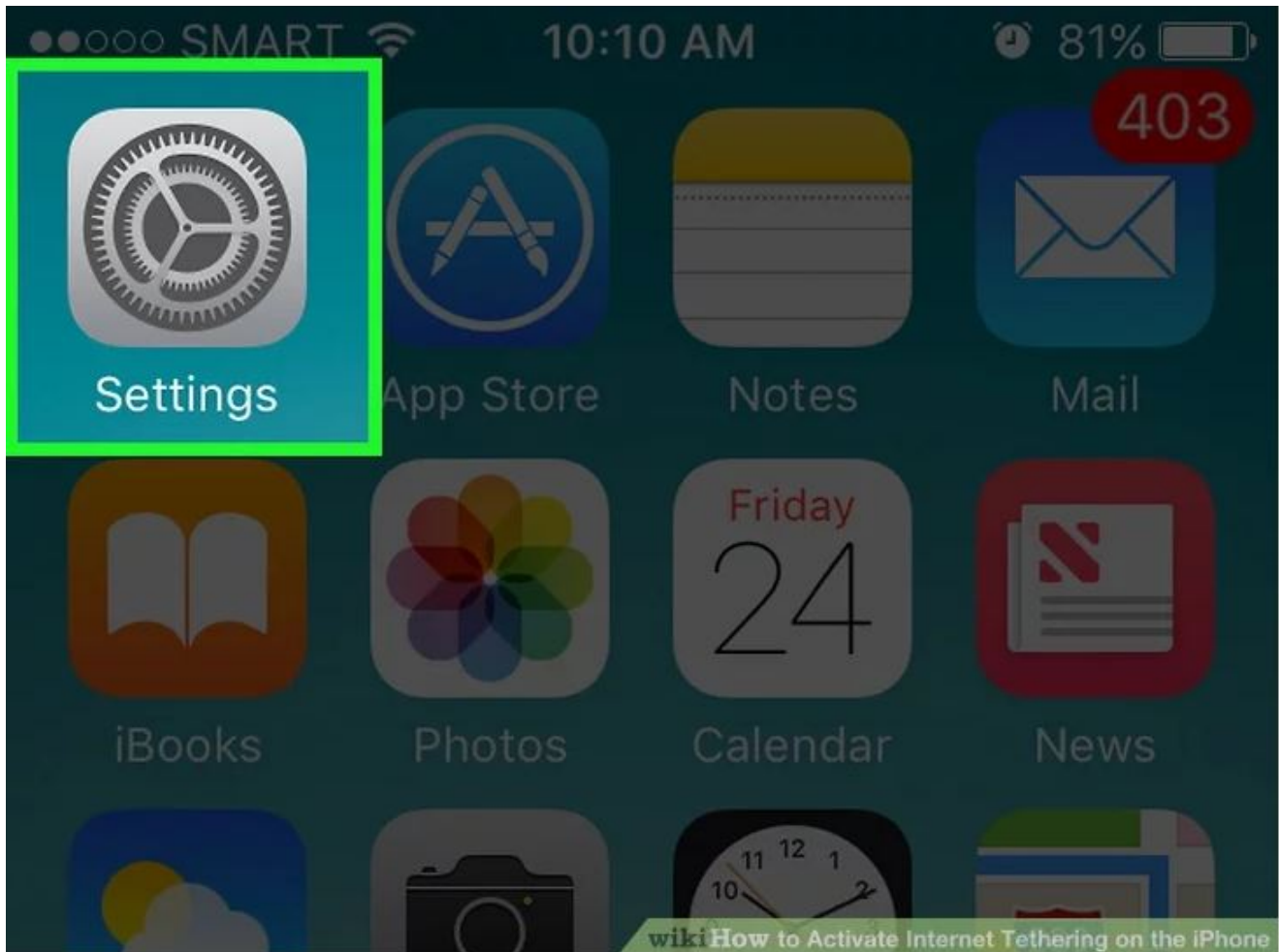
Step 1: On your phone, get your hotspot's network name & password.

1. Open your device's Settings app .
2. Tap **Network & Internet** > **Hotspot & tethering**.
3. Tap **Set up Wi-Fi hotspot**.
4. Tap **Show password**.

Step 2: On the other device, connect to your hotspot.

1. Open that device's list of Wi-Fi options.
2. On that list, pick the hotspot network name.
3. Enter the hotspot password.
4. Click **Connect**.

On an Apple iPhone:



- 1** **Open the iPhone's Settings.** You can find the Settings app on your Home screen. The icon is a gray gear.



2 Tap the **Personal Hotspot** option. This can be found in the first group of options in the Settings menu.

- If you don't see this option, tap **Cellular** (or **Mobile Data** on a British phone) and then tap **Set Up Personal Hotspot**. You may be prompted to call your carrier to subscribe to a plan that supports the Personal Hotspot feature. It may require an additional fee.
- If you don't see the **Personal Hotspot** option anywhere, either on the main Settings menu or in the Cellular menu, you'll need to contact your carrier.

- 3** Enable the **Personal Hotspot** switch. It will turn green. If your plan does not support tethering, or additional confirmation is required, you'll be notified to contact your carrier before you can proceed.

2 Enter the password when prompted.

Other users will join your shared Wi-Fi network using this password.

The password must contain at least 8 characters. Changing the password will disconnect any currently connected users.

- 5** **Type a password for your wireless network.** Make sure that the password is strong and not easily-guessable, especially if you're in a public place.

Open the list of available networks on another device. The process for this varies depending on your device, but you'll be connecting to your iPhone like you would any other wireless network .
